


EXPLANATORY NOTE

Citizens' voluntary law-enforcement involvement includes working without pay within the structure of a police organization in order to supplement and assist it in the performance of its duties. PNP force-multipliers have long been employed to improve outcomes in our public safety. They play a vital role in ensuring efficient deliverance of services to the people.

Ever since the country has been placed under different levels of community quarantine, force multipliers have been deployed to implement stricter border control. They provide the PNP with information or beef up the number of policemen out on patrol. Having extra sets of eyes and ears helps a lot in anti-crime operations.

This measure seeks to provide qualified force multipliers with a retirement benefit most appropriate considering their dedication and commitment in assisting the PNP and the government in protecting the citizenry and deterring crime to improve public safety.

Thus, the immediate passage of this bill is earnestly sought.

AN ACT
PROVIDING RETIREMENT BENEFIT TO FORCE MULTIPLIER

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled

SECTION 1. Short Title. This Act shall be known as the “Lingkod Retirement Benefit for Force Multiplier Act of 2021”

SECTION 2. Retirement Benefit. There is hereby established a retirement benefit for a force multiplier in the amount of Fifty Thousand Pesos (PHP 50,000.00).

SECTION 3. Eligibility. Any force multiplier shall be entitled to the said benefit *Provided* that he/she shall be at least Sixty (65) years of age and with at least ten (10) years in service. *Provided* further that any such volunteer who dies or becomes permanently incapacitated while in the performance of his/her duty shall be entitled to the benefit irrespective of his/her age and number of years in service.

SECTION 4. Force Multiplier Retirement Fund. There is hereby created a Force Multiplier Retirement Fund (FMRF) which shall be used to fund the retirement of force multipliers mentioned in this Act. The amount equivalent to one percent (1%) of the share of the national government under Section 284 of the Local Government Code of 1991, as amended, shall be used for this purpose.

The Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) shall administer and ensure the appropriate disbursement of the fund.

SECTION 5. Implementing Rules and Regulations. Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, The Department of Budget and Management (DBM), in the coordination with the DILG, shall issue the necessary rules and regulations to implement this Act.

SECTION 6. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Act is declared unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity and effectivity of the other provisions hereof.

SECTION 7. Repealing Clause. All laws, decrees, orders, issuances or portion thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. Effectivity. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
