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**AN ACT DECLARING THE MUNICIPALITY OF PARACALE IN THE PROVINCE OF CAMARINES NORTE AS AN ECOTOURISM ZONE AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR**

*EXPLANATORY NOTE*

Camarines Norte has been identified in the Department of Tourism's National Tourism Masterplan as a Tourism Development Area. This designation signals the importance to lay down measures which will improve and enhance the tourism capabilities of the province to goals of the Masterplan.

Indeed Camarines Norte is still a vastly untapped tourism destination and surely, among the many towns in Camarines Norte, the town of Paracale is definitely one of those that stands out with respect to ecotourism potential.

Paracale is home to the *Parroquia de Nuestra Senora de Candelaria*, the oldest church in the Province and probably the region and boasts of many pristine beaches at par with the best the Philippines has to offer.

Pulang Daga Beach, Buhangin Beach, Gumaus Beach and Macolabo Island are some of the best places in Camarines Norte to visit.

In light of the huge potential of the Municipality of Paracale to become a top tourist destination, it is hereby sought that the Municipality of Paracale in the Province of Camarines Norte be declared as an Ecotourism Zone. The passage of this bill will surely create new jobs, improve the local livelihood and will be beneficial for the domestic economy.

In view of the foregoing, the passage of this bill is earnestly sought.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1           **SECTION 1.** *Short Title.* This Act shall be known as the "Paracale Ecotourism Act of 2022".  
2

3           **SECTION 2.** *Declaration of Policy.* It is hereby declared the policy of the State to promote a  
4 sustainable and effective ecotourism industry to attract tourists, both local and foreign. Towards this end,  
5 the country should rationalize all efforts to make the tourism industry a major source of livelihood and an  
6 avenue for economic development. Moreover, measures should be taken to ensure that tourism  
7 development would be done with a view on the preservation of the existing ecosystem and natural  
8 environment.  
9

10           **SECTION 3.** *Paracale Ecotourism Zone.* –The Municipality of Paracale in the Province of  
11 Camarines Norte is hereby declared as an Ecotourism Zone. As such, its development shall be prioritized  
12 by the Department of Tourism (DOT) and other concerned agencies, subject to the rules and regulations  
13 governing the development of ecotourism zones.  
14

15           In particular, the development of the following areas will be given focus by the DOT, the  
16 concerned government agencies and also the Municipality of Paracale, Province of Camarines Norte, to  
17 wit:

- 18  
19           a. Puland Daga Beach;  
20           b. Buhangin Beach;  
21           c. Gumaus Beach;  
22           d. Macolabo Island; and  
23           e. The immediate environs of the *Parroquia de Nuestra Senora de Candelaria*.

24  
25       **SECTION 4. *Ecotourism Governing Board.*** – Within one (1) year from the approval of this Act,  
26 there shall be created the Paracale Ecotourism Governing Board, to be composed of the following:  
27

- 28       a. Mayor of the Municipality of Paracale, as *ex-officio* Chairperson  
29       b. Secretary of the Department of Tourism or a duly-authorized representative, as member;  
30       c. Secretary of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources or a duly-authorized  
31       representative, as member;  
32       d. Representative of the 1<sup>st</sup> District of Camarines Norte or a duly-authorized representative, as  
33       member;  
34       e. Representative from an accredited non-governmental organization whose advocacy is  
35       environmental preservation, as member;  
36       f. Representative of the academe, as member; and  
37       g. Representative from the business sector, as member.  
38

39       The Board shall prepare the necessary rules and regulations for the proper implementation of  
40 this Act and shall, when necessary, amend, modify or revise such rules and regulations to meet existing  
41 needs.  
42

43       The Municipal Government of Paracale shall provide a secretariat for the Board including the  
44 funding necessary to cover expenses for the performance of its official functions and activities.  
45

46       **SECTION 5. *Ecotourism Development Plan.*** – Within one (1) year from the approval of this Act,  
47 the DOT, in coordination with the local government unit of Paracale, the Representative of the 1<sup>st</sup> District  
48 of Camarines Norte and other concerned government agencies, shall prepare an ecotourism  
49 development plan containing, among others, the construction, installation and maintenance of such  
50 appropriate facilities and infrastructure that shall enhance tourism in the Municipality of Paracale,  
51 particularly in the areas mentioned in Section 3 hereof; Provided, that the said development plan shall  
52 ensure the preservation and conservation of the natural beauty and indigenous nature of the locality.  
53

54       **SECTION 6. *Implementation of the Plan.*** The DOT shall take immediate steps in implementing  
55 the ecotourism development plan and incorporate the same in its overall development plans and  
56 programs for national implementation.  
57

58       **SECTION 7. *Appropriations.*** The Secretary of the DOT shall include in the Department's  
59 program, the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General  
60 Appropriations Act and internally generated funds of the DOT.  
61

62       **SECTION 8. *Separability Clause.*** – If any provision of this Act shall be declared unconstitutional  
63 or invalid, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.  
64

65       **SECTION 9. *Repealing Clause.*** – All laws, rules, regulations, presidential decrees, and other  
66 issuances inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.  
67

68       **SECTION 10. *Effectivity Clause.*** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication  
69 in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.

71       **Approved.**
