Explanatory Note

This bill seeks to convert the Zabarte Road located in the First District of Caloocan City into a national road.

This thoroughfare stretching around 3.3 kilometers in length has served as the main road for hundreds of motorists plying across this busy road everyday, thus it easily meet the criteria necessary for its conversion into a national road.

The conversion of the Zabarte Road into a national road will ensure its proper maintenance. Unlike when left under the care of the local government which is saddled with broad responsibilities and with limited budget to boot, motorists can be assured of its efficiency and reliability in near absolute guarantee.

The Zabarte Road, when properly maintain and improved, could be a major contributor in easing or mitigating the traffic problem which is now a commonplace in Metro Manila. This will have the effect of enhancing the people's productive time and increase commercial transactions that further the economy.

In view of the foregoing, the immediate consideration and approval of this bill is highly recommended.

AN ACT
CONVERTING THE ZABARTE ROAD IN THE FIRST DISTRICT OF
CALOOCAN CITY INTO A NATIONAL ROAD AND APPROPRIATING
FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The Zabarte Road located in the First District of Caloocan City is hereby converted into a national road under the supervision of the Department of Public Works and Highways.

SEC. 2. The Secretary of the Department of Public Works and Highways shall include in the Department' program the improvement, repair and maintenance of the said road, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
